**Notes and Frequently Asked Questions**

1	Who is the primary applicant? The membership will be registered under the name of the primary applicant.
2	Who is an associate member? This is the spouse or partner of the primary applicant. Membership also includes children under the age of 18 (please list separately if a name badge is required).
3	The Club’s magazine and correspondence will be mailed to your postal address or sent as an email.
4	Which cars should I list on my registration form? Please list all Mercedes-Benz vehicles that you currently own. We like keeping accurate statistics on all cars owned by our members, whether they are old or new. Please notify the Club’s Registrar (registrar@mbcv.org.au) when you sell, buy or change cars in the future.
5	What is the joining fee? The joining fee applies for all new members. However, the joining fee is waived for the following applicants: (a) children of members who join the Club on attaining the age of 18 years; (b) current financial members of other Mercedes-Benz Clubs who also wish to join our Club.
6	What is the express membership option? Your application is usually ratified at the monthly committee meeting. We offer an Express Membership where approval is sought prior to a committee meeting. Normally this can be confirmed within two weeks, but will incur a \$250 surcharge. <b>PLEASE NOTE:</b> The surcharge is <b>in addition</b> to the \$45 joining fee and the \$85 annual subscription. That is, a total of \$380. The Express Membership is useful in cases when you are applying for the Club Permit Scheme and have a valid roadworthy certificate that will shortly expire.

7	<p>What are the full and half annual subscription periods? If you join between 17 April 2017 and 20 November 2017, you must pay the <u>full annual membership</u> and joining fee, and your next renewal will be on 1 July 2018.</p> <p>If your application is received after 20 November 2017 and before 16 April 2018, <u>the half-year membership</u> is applicable. In this case, renewal of your membership will be on 1 July 2018. Please note that there is no committee meeting in December therefore, for applications received after 20 November 2017, memberships will be ratified at the January committee meeting on 15 Jan 2018.</p>
8	<p>Who gets a name badge? Your membership entitles you to one free name badge with a safety pin type catch. This can be upgraded to a magnetic backed catch for \$5. Additional badges for the associate member and children can be ordered (see price list).</p>
9	<p>What payment options are available? We accept cheques, Mastercard or Visa. Please make the cheque payable to <i>Mercedes-Benz Club of Victoria</i>. We <b>do not accept</b> Diners Club and American Express.</p>
10	<p>Please provide any additional information if required. For example: your membership of other interstate MB Clubs; associate member applying for a separate membership because now aged 18 years; express membership request.</p>
	<p>What happens after you submit the membership form? Your application needs to be ratified at a committee meeting. The committee usually meets on the third Monday of each month except for December. If your membership is accepted, a confirmation letter will be posted to you shortly after the meeting.</p>
	<p>What is needed to apply for the Club Permit Scheme (CPS)? Your Mercedes-Benz vehicle must be at least 25 years old and you are required to do the steps in the order listed:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Become a member of the MBCV. The car must be registered with the primary applicant.</li> <li>2. Obtain a road worthy certificate (RWC) for your vehicle; MBCV do not scrutinise vehicles. We suggest you arrange the RWC <u>after</u> you become a member.</li> <li>3. Take digital photographs of your vehicle as described in the CPS information sheet, viewable from our Club's website.</li> <li>4. A receipt/ticket for the \$100 deposit submitted through the TryBooking MBCV CPS application deposit site: <a href="http://www.trybooking.com/JSVN">www.trybooking.com/JSVN</a> must accompany the initial CPS application (not required for the CPS renewal).</li> <li>5. Have an authorised Club Permit Safety Officer (phone numbers are in the Club magazine) to sign off on your VicRoads application. A membership number and your digital photographs are required before this signing off can occur.</li> <li>6. Notify the Club Registrar (<a href="mailto:registrar@mbcv.org.au">registrar@mbcv.org.au</a>) of the CPS registration number assigned to the car. The \$100 TryBooking deposit is only refunded after this notification.</li> </ol> <p>Please refer to <a href="http://www.vicroads.vic.gov.au">www.vicroads.vic.gov.au</a> for general information about the Club Permit Scheme.</p>
