Reopening Club events – COVID-19 guidelines

The following are guidelines for the organising and running Club events as a consequence of the COVID-19 pandemic. We ask all committee members, register captains and other event organisers to follow these guidelines:

- a) Adherence to the Victorian State Government restriction imposed at the time of holding any event. This includes the maximum number of attendees any specific event and/or imposed by the venue, whichever is the smaller number. *
- b) Events are for financial MBCV members only due to the restricted numbers.
- c) All events must be booked ahead of time. People who have not booked will be asked not to participate.
- d) If the event includes a venue, then entry is only by presentation of a TryBooking ticket. Any pre-conditions imposed by the venue must be determined beforehand, e.g. numbers of participants, seating arrangement, reservation deposit, etc.
- e) Clearly advise participants that the event is only for individuals who are healthy: “If in doubt, then pull out!”
- f) Please discourage participants who are at high risk when affected by the infection; including but not limited to: old age, high blood pressure, heart or respiratory conditions etc.
- g) Proper hygiene protocols are to be used by everyone, including hand sanitation, appropriate social distancing etc.
- h) Please exercise social distancing at the initial meeting point. You may even wish to tell people to remain in their cars.

It is particularly important that you have the names and contact details of ALL people attending an event; this information will be critical if contact tracing is needed, hence the mandatory use of the TryBooking system.

As the government restrictions are changing rapidly and often, the conditions pertaining to your event may need to be adjusted to suit. Most of these suggestions are common sense, but it does not hurt to point these out to your participants.

Moving forward, we are excited at becoming a more active Club but we need to do this in a healthy and responsible manner with good social consciousness.
